Mobile Access Action Wizard

This tutorial provides you the information needed to setup a mobile access action via the notification wizards.

To get to the starting point of this tutorial:

- Log in as administrator
- Click the “Notifications” tab

1. Adding a notification


a) First click on the “notification wizard”



b) You will now have the notification wizard page displayed, like below.



c) Select mobile access from the notification type options.




Please choose a name for your **Mobile Access** Action. Descriptive Action names increase the simplicity of the system.

This is a preview of the message that will be visible on your mobile. The message visible will include the details relevant to your sensor.

Click **Customize** to change the format of this message. The items in your message with a dollar sign and parentheses e.g. \$[TIME] represents the data to be imported into your message at the time of sending. Please click the Macro Description button for a full list.

The Mobile Log Number is the maximum number of notification messages that will be stored on the securityProbe. These messages will be read only when a mobile phone connects to the system, via Bluetooth, data call or GPRS. A new message will be stored in the Log after each event.



Define the number of re-notification attempts and the interval between each.

Click **Finish** to Save your Action
